

Maquoketa Valley Electric Cooperative (MVEC) is a well-established rural electric Cooperative, providing service in rural Iowa since 1936. MVEC is incorporated in Iowa and maintains a status of “active and in good standing” with the Iowa Secretary of State.

In 2016, MVEC undertook a major upgrade to support its smart grid technology, including the deployment a fiber optic network, which can also be used to provide high-speed broadband Internet access and other advanced services. In 2017, MVEC began offering broadband Internet access and interconnected VoIP service to both business and residential members within their service territory, using their fiber facilities.

MVEC serves approximately 18,000 electric meters and 14,000 members in Dubuque, Delaware, Jackson, and Jones counties as well as portions of Cedar, Clinton, Clayton, Linn and Buchanan Counties. MVEC currently has 74 employees and maintains its headquarters in Anamosa, IA.
