

# City's fiber project progressing well

Schoon Construction trucks can be seen all over Manning as work crews install Manning's new fiber optic cable bringing higher band width and better service to MMCTSU customers.

Manning Municipal Utilities Manager Jeremy Carroll said, "About 60 percent of carrier pipe (duct) is in the ground, cutover crews are prewiring businesses and homes, and early August crews will start putting fiber into the duct."

By mid-August Carroll expects to have fiber connected to businesses. Residential connections will follow.

All the equipment for

the headend, which communicates with homes, has arrived and is being installed. Testing will soon begin.

He said the dry conditions have made it very difficult for workmen to properly repair lawns. Once there is more moisture in the soil, he assured residents addition lawn repair will be done.
